How often can I or members of my household bring items to Dumpster Days?

Each household will have the opportunity to use our Dumpster Day Program **THREE (3)** times throughout the 2017 season, **per address.**

How do I get a card?

- Upon entering for the first time, a Department of Public Service employee will confirm your residency as usual and ask you to record your name and address on a spreadsheet which will indicate what card number you will be given.
- They will then give you a numbered wallet-sized Dumpster Day Card which will allow for 3 hole-punches. You will then need to fill out the Dumpster Day Card with your name and address.
- Each time a resident or a member of their household uses the card it will receive a hole-punch. The first visit will be considered the first of three visits and your card will be hole-punched when you enter the gate.

Residents must have the card with them to use our Dumpster Day Program – NO EXCEPTIONS

The following Rules

1. All loads will be inspected.
2. Up to one (1) pickup truck full allowed per visit. Trucks with sides constructed above original side/wall of truck bed are **NOT** permitted.
3. Paint cans, barrels, drums, tanks **must be empty with lids removed.**
4. Brush and tree limbs accepted; must be kept separate from other waste. Brush and tree limbs will not be considered as one of your three (3) visits. (Mulch is made available free of charge to Township residents).
5. NOT permitted to be used for commercial or industrial businesses.
6. NOT intended for raw garbage or as a substitute for your household garbage collection.
