RESOLUTION # 17-007

**AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE ODOT WINTER CONTRACT (018-18)
FOR SODIUM CHLORIDE (ROCK SALT) FOR THE 2017-2018 WINTER SEASON.**

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Lucas County, Ohio, met in regular session on April 17, 2017 at 7617 Angola Road, Holland, Ohio, with the following members present:

Marylin Yoder moved the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Springfield Township, Lucas County Ohio (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision") hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual winter road salt bid (018-18) in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT winter road salt contract:

THEREFORE, it is **RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees, Springfield Township, as follows:

1. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the winter road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
2. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the winter road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
3. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT winter road salt contract and agrees to hold the Department of Transportation harmless for any claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of the Political Subdivision's participation in the winter road salt contract; and
4. The Political Subdivision hereby requests through this participation agreement a total of 1000 tons of Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) of which the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
5. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its above-requested salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period of October 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018; and
