RESOLUTION 17-012

**ESTABLISHING "NO PARKING" ON BOTH SIDES OF NIGHTINGALE DRIVE FROM  
HOLLOWAY ROAD TO PEACOCK LANE**

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Lucas County, Ohio, met in Regular Session on September 18, 2017, at 7617 Angola Road, Holland, Ohio, with the following members present:

Robert Bethel, Marylin Yoder and Andrew Glenn

Marylin Yoder moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17 authorizes the Board of Trustees to make such regulations and orders as are necessary to control all vehicle parking in the township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of public safety and the general welfare of Springfield Township to prohibit vehicular parking on both sides of Nightingale Drive between Holloway Road and Peacock Lane.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by Springfield Township Board of Trustees, Lucas County, Ohio:

1. That in the interest of public safety and the general welfare of Springfield Township vehicular parking hereby is prohibited on both sides of Nightingale Drive between Holloway Road and Peacock Lane; and
2. That the Township shall erect and maintain appropriate "No Parking" signs upon both sides of Nightingale Drive between Holloway Road and Peacock Lane; and
3. That whoever violates this Resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor; and
4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the latter of (i) thirty (30) days following posting of this Resolution in five (5) conspicuous places in the township, and (ii) publication of this Resolution in a newspaper of general circulation in the Springfield Township for three (3) consecutive weeks; and
5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

Andrew Glenn seconded the motion and roll was called on the question of its adoption. Vote was as follows:
