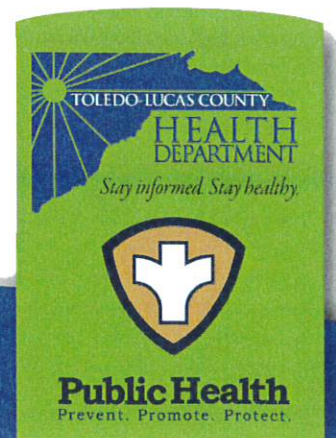


Lucas County COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution: Phase 1B Communication-Week 5

Vaccinations in Phase 1B started on January 18th. Scheduling for the 4th week of Phase 1B is now open.

- ✓ **The week of Jan. 19:** 80 years of age and older.
 - ✓ **The week of Jan. 25:** 75 years of age and older; those with a disability AND have a condition or disorder.
 - ✓ **The week of Feb. 1:** 70 years of age and older; employees of K-12 schools. (scheduling opens Jan 28)
 - ✓ **The week of Feb. 8:** 65 years of age and older.
 - ✓ **The week of Feb. 15:** Individuals with any of the qualifying conditions (listed below) (scheduling open Feb 11) and those who are 65 years of age and older.
- **Qualifying conditions** are cerebral palsy; spina bifida; severe congenital heart disease requiring hospitalization within the past year; severe type 1 diabetes requiring hospitalization within the past year; inherited metabolic disorders including phenylketonuria; severe neurological disorders including epilepsy, hydrocephaly, and microcephaly; severe genetic disorders including Down syndrome, fragile X syndrome, Prader-Willi syndrome, Turner syndrome, and muscular dystrophy; severe lung disease, including asthma requiring hospitalization within the past year, and cystic fibrosis; sickle cell anemia; and alpha and beta thalassemia; and solid organ transplants.
 - Vaccine recipients must be age 16 or older to be eligible for the Pfizer vaccine, and age 18 or older to be eligible for the Moderna vaccine.
 - *Those with a qualifying conditions will be required to attest to this when scheduling online and also at the time of the appointment.*
 - All **veterans** are eligible to schedule a vaccine appointment through the Veterans Administration, regardless of current services received. If a veteran is currently receiving services, they may be asked to supply their DD-214 (discharge paperwork). Please call 419-259-2000, press 0.
 - **Scheduling may be done 3 ways:**
 1. Visit <https://lucascountyhealth.com/covidvaccine/> to pick from a list of providers.
 2. Call United Way's 2-1-1: Available to assist those who are disabled, multilingual support, have no access to technology, or are experiencing technical difficulties.
 3. Call the Area Office on Aging: Service available for older adults in the community who need assistance scheduling appointments. 419-382-0624.

- Any individuals with one of the conditions above AND an intellectual or developmental disability who have not yet received the vaccine should contact their local board of developmental disabilities for assistance scheduling an appointment.
- Other eligible 1B groups (65+, those with a severe congenital, developmental or early onset disorder) can still schedule an appointment as we continue through the remaining Phase 1B weeks.
- Please understand, vaccine supply continues to be very limited and we ask for citizens to please continue to be patient when trying to schedule an appointment.
